NEED AN ANGEL came away in good order, went to the early lead, controlled the tempo while well off the rail, moved closer to the inside near the half-mile pole, vied off the rail while under some urging on the turn, was asked for more near the five-sixteenths pole, drew clear under right hand urging in upper stretch, continued under right hand urging into the final sixteenth then was eased up while much the best. FORTHELOVEOF ANNA stalked the leader on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, dropped further behind the leader while under left hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. MY HONEY LAURIE was rated at the back of the compact field, tucked into the two path leaving the backstretch, shifted three wide when asked near the three-eighths pole, moved to four wide while under a drive passing the five-sixteenths, continued four wide into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and weakened while best of the rest. SEEING CLEARLY settled off the early pace, moved up outside the half-mile pole, raced just behind the leader, came under some urging while inside on the turn, was asked for more outside the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and had nothing left.
