WEEKEND HIDEAWAY hustled from the get go, set a solid prompted pace from just off the inside, came under encouragement at the top of the stretch swinging four wide, went clear through the lane under a drive until being geared down just inside the final sixteenth. SHOT ROCK midpack early on three to four wide through the turn, maneuvered to the rail at the three-sixteenths, proved no match for the top one while hooking up to win a head to head battle through the final furlong for place honors, digging in with good energy to the wire. SMOOTH BERT two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths, progressed on the front, swung four wide for home, split foes arriving into contention with a furlong to go, fought on head to head to the wire with good energy for the place honors but was forced to settle for show. TWEET ME hustled from the start, prompted the pace from the three path, got shaken off after straightening for home, weakened in the final furlong. HOOKED FOREVER outrun in the early going, came under a drive from the three-eighths, circled four wide in upper stretch and passed tired foes through the lane. THANK'S FORTHE SON chased from towards the rear taking the overland route throughout and offered no response when set down. RICHIESBRONXBOMBER urged along in midpack just off the inside from the seven-sixteenths, tired in the stretch then was vanned off after the finish. HORATIO in close pursuit of the front, had the rider take a good hold on the near side rein as his charge tried to get out through the turn, drifted out two to three paths nearing the quarter pole before weakening through the stretch.
