INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$4,000 will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 122 lbs.; TURF: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf, 5 lbs.; A sweepstake on the turf; or two races on the turf, 7 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt allowed 3 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the dirt, 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered for turf and dirt.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 28, 2012 with 35 Nominations.

QUICK WIT was well placed under some urging while off the rail, continued in that position into the far turn, split rivals to make a bid with three furlongs to run, was asked nearing the quarter-pole then set down in earnest after straightening for the drive, battled on the outside of CSABA while under strong hand urging, came under a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker, continued to battle with the aforementioned rival, switched to a right-handed whip late and narrowly prevailed under mostly hand urging in the final strides. CSABA bumped with a rival at the start, went to the lead, set the pace through solid fractions, was asked midway through the far turn, vied on the inside of QUICK WIT, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, dueled with the aforementioned rival and just missed. DADDY NOSE BEST raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with five furlongs to run, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, came under right hand urging at the quarter-pole, switched to a left-handed whip inside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and failed to threaten. OPTIMIZER was asked some into the first turn, dropped to the inside early on that bend, settled off the inside on the backstretch, chased three then four wide on the far turn, came under the whip outside the quarter-pole, continued under the whip in upper stretch and tired. SKYRING bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, went two to three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied three wide under urging on the far turn and capitulated. RACONTEUR went four then three wide on the first turn, was urged along on the outside, went three wide on the far turn and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.
