MOONLIGHT SONG was away alertly from the outside post, cruised to the early lead, set the pace through soft fractions, controlled the tempo while off the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth while still under right-hand urging, drifted out late and held sway. TENANGO acted-up just before the start but broke with the field, settled on the outside, ranged up under coaxing while four wide early on the turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, chased into upper stretch, came under a left-handed whip, pursued the winner into the final furlong while being gathered up by the rider, was switched to a right-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly but missed. ITHASTOBEGEORGE settled just off the pace, dropped back a bit while off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide while asked near the three-eighths, continued four wide into the stretch, pursued the top two under a strong right-handed whip and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. MAKE YOUR MOVE settled on the inside, dropped back outside the five-eighths pole, raced towards the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, came in a bit under a left-handed whip in upper stretch and failed to rally. TUG OF WAR was reluctant to load, raced off the pace while ridden along, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. INTERMIX (IRE) tracked the pace, was asked while three wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and tired. LIBERAL SPIN was last to commence, settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while three wide on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, came under a right-handed whip and failed to threaten.
