Footnotes

IN TROUBLE gave chase on the embattled pair up ahead from the three path, under some urging for most of the way around the bend, was well within striking distance of them under a drive spinning into the lane, arrived at the eighth pole as the primary pursuer, drew on even terms with SOUND OF FREEDOM in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, took over for good soon afterwards and gradually kicked away, crossing the finish line under a hand drive. SOUND OF FREEDOM broke sharply, was given several taps in the area of the right shoulder and got angled over to rail, making it there before the top of the turn, vied to maintain command with TIZNOWFORAMERICA pressing the issue parked to the outside, was asked for a response prior to cutting the corner into the lane, but a few strides after the previously-mentioned rival had been, completed the ensuing furlong comfortably in front, but with the runner up still pursuing in earnest, had that opponent draw abreast with about a sixteenth to go, relinquished a couple of jumps later, fell back steadily while finishing well clear of the others for the place. TIZNOWFORAMERICA bumped with ROBERTO GATO at the start, shook if off and moved up to engage the second place finisher, sparred from the two path with that foe during the run around the bend, needed some urging by the five-sixteenths marker to keep pace, remained in contention for another furlong before weakening. MOSLER chased the disputed pace from off the inside, tipped one path wider with an eighth to go, lacked the needed response. POINT HOPE fractious in the post parade, flung off the rider, but was expertly kept hold by the pilot and prevented from running off, acted up once more, buck-jumping during the first loading attempt, proceeded to come out a tad slowly but without apparent mishap, raced from off the inside, intermittently given some light stick work near the right shoulder, but without any pick up in interest, was already under solid encouragement entering the stretch, made no impact. HAIL TO THE NILE three wide entering the turn, was in the four path exiting it, never reached a contending position. ROBERTO GATO took a hesitant step before coming out slightly, but enough to bump with the nearest opponent, drifted out slightly, ranking fighting against the bit heading for the end of the backstretch, vacated the inside route past the midway point on the turn, was under urging fanning about five wide, the widest of all, into the lane, had no offering. BORSEGGIATORE saved ground, was asked for some run by the three-eighths pole, faltered.
