Footnotes

DANGEROUS LAD unhurried from off the inside during the very earliest stages, picked up interest upon entering the backstretch, splitting some rivals to improve position, maintained the momentum upon entering the far turn scurrying into a strong contending position by its end, commenced the stretch four wide, mustered up a solid kick to take charge by the eighth pole, showed good determination in the late stages to preserve the decision. YELLOW MOUNTAIN (IRE) was grabbed hold shying inward from pressure coming from WILLY ELLIOT as the field was sent on its way, tucked along the rail well before reaching the end of the homestretch, rode it until the five-sixteenths pole, was let out a notch and picking up speed noticeably getting taken outward, settling into the six path by the head of the stretch, came home with good energy to garner the place. RIVENDELL bobbled at the start, was guided over to the inside route, stayed put for nearly three-quarters, got asked for run entering the stretch, altered course gradually several paths in total during the run through the furlong grounds, flashed a strong belated burst to grab the show award. VALID tracked the front runners while sitting the pocket until upper stretch, remained a forward factor before weakening in the late stages. GHOST HUNTER sat well reserved in the two path in midpack, spun into the stretch behind a wall of rivals, was kept on hold by the pilot, altered course to the inside in search of better racing room, once VALID had abandoned it, remained on hold, lacking optimal clearance idling behind the former pacesetter, had that opponent inadvertently drift inward in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, getting put into tight quarters, bumped with that foe and then brushed the rail, gained sufficient soon afterwards, but showed no real interest, kept to less than brisk hand urging the rest of the way. TWO SEVENTEEN grabbed the advantage and was placed along the rail, set the pace, rated and being

accompanied by WILLY ELLIOT parked to the outside, was put to the test as the third fraction was being recorded and get let out, yielded before completing the next furlong and backed away. ABRAHAM lunged at the start, making solid contact with the left side, sat forwardly placed in the three path around both turns, folded. PEACE AND JUSTICE bore out racing around each bend, was never in contention. LEADEM IN KEN strung out four wide on the opening turn, raced closer to the rail on the subsequent one, felt the whip leaving the three-eighths pole, failed to respond and tired. WILLY ELLIOT broke inward, stalked the pacesetter from the outside for three-quarters and gave way.
