ORIENTATE contested the pace from the outside, drew away when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. MOUNT INTREPID was outrun early, raced inside and rallied inside to get the place spot. EVENING ATTIRE was outrun early, raced wide and offered a mild rally outside. DEFERRED COMP was outrun along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. VINO SOLO was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. MON COME KING had no response when roused. MUCH TOO TOUGH tired after a wide trip. SING IT OUT chased inside and tired. PROBABLY'S DEVIL contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. FINAL DREAM chased outside and tired.
