ORIENTATE broke running, set the pace while well in hand, drew clear when asked for run and was ridden out to the finish. SAY FLORIDA SANDY chased the pace from the outside, could not handle the winner but continued on gamely to be clearly best of the others. MULTIPLE CHOICE raced close up early, put in a three wide run approaching the stretch and had little left for the drive. LATE CARSON hit the gate at the start, was outrun early, put in a four wide run nearing the stretch and lacked a solid finishing kick. BEAU'S TOWN tired after showing brief speed. TEXAS GLITTER stumbled at the start, chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
