(UP TO \$12,350 NYSBFOA) INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES FOUR YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON \$50,000 ON THE TURF IN 2003-04. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. \$100 to enter and \$100 to start, with \$65,000 added. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf in 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 in 2003-04; or four races, 5 lbs.; three races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). Highweights preferred. Ties broken by total turf earnings. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Thursday, August 5, 2004 with 39 Nominations.

PERSONAL LEGEND settled in good position while saving ground, raced in good position along the inside to the turn, angled out in upper stretch, closed the gap in midstretch the finished with a flourish to wear down LENTIL in the final strides. LENTIL sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the lead to the top of the stretch, dug in when threatened in upper stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. VESPER was unhurried for six furlongs while saving ground, launched a rally along the inside on the turn, angled out for clear sailing nearing the furlong marker then finished full of run from outside but could not get up. LOJO stalked the leader in the two path for five furlongs, made a from from outside to challenge entering the stretch, battled heads apart into midstretch and weakened late. LADY LINDA trailed along the backstretch, raced well back while saving ground on the turn then rallied belatedly along the inside. ERASE stalked the pace while three wide to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. SEVEN MOONS (JPN) never reached contention while four wide. SOMETHING VENTURED raced in the middle of the pack while three wide for six furlongs and lacked a further response.
