WICKED FUNNY raced with the pace while in hand, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. BLUE FOREST chased the pace from the outside and dug in stubbornly along the inside in the stretch. THESCHEMEOFTHINGS raced in hand while well and finished well outside. CONTAGIOUS (GB) raced in hand while between rivals and posed no real threat. FASTER TAPPER was hustled to the front, set the pace and tired in the stretch. VERKHOTINA (GB) was steadied after the start, raced inside and lacked a rally. ALBANY COUNTY raced three wide and failed to menace. ESPLANADE was steadied along inside and was in hand along the inside in the stretch. STORM A BREWING raced wide throughout and had no impact on the outcome.
