Footnotes

ICY CITY hit the side of the gate and bobbled then ducked out at the start, moved up from outside, angled in on the far turn, shot through along the rail to take command in upper stretch and edged clear under right hand urging. SAGAMOON broke inward causing crowding at the start, prompted the pace from outside, angled three wide while rallying in upper stretch, made a run to threaten in midstretch but was no match for the winner. PRECIOUS TOO steadied after being pinched back at the start, raced well back early, circled five wide leaving the turn and lacked a strong closing response. MY KITTY was bumped at the start, steadied in traffic at the half mile pole, raced three wide to the turn and finished evenly. DONTDRINKTHEPUNCH raced in midpack while three wide for a half and tired. ALL FIRED UP steadied after being pinched back at the start, steadied in tight along the rail at the half mile pole and failed to seriously threaten thereafter. NORDBERG bobbled at the start, sprinted clear early, set the pace along the inside for a half, came off the rail entering the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. CAUGHT RED HANDED raced between horses while three wide along the backstretch, swung six wide on the turn and gave way at the top of the stretch.
