FLYING SAPPHO broke out a bit at the start but showed good speed, dueled on the inside of MISS BETTE M, disposed of that rival leaving the turn, extended the lead in upper stretch and maintained a safe advantage under intermittent right hand urging. GLORY CHASER was taken back under a very strong hold on the inside, continued to give a bit of ground while under heavy restraint, eased off the rail outside the quarter-pole, was roused and came between rivals in upper stretch then willingly earned the place while no threat to the winner. PEA STONE settled nicely off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick then was denied the place. SONG FOR PUPCAKE was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. AURIC GIRL was bumped at the start, tried to savage MISS BETTE M then was taken up, raced at the rear of the field while under restraint, waited behind traffic while a bit off the rail on the turn, moved out near the furlong marker and also improved position. HUNT FOR CANDIE settled on the outside, was urged while three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ANGEL WAVE bumped with a rival at the start, dropped back a bit then angled to the rail, was urged some on the inside, came off the rail early on the turn, steadied off heels at the top of the stretch, had her path taken shortly thereafter and had nothing left. MISS DOLAN'S ROSE broke inward and bumped with a rival then was taken up, settled well back in the field, bided her time while three wide on the turn, checked off heels at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. HUNNY OF A TOUR brushed with a rival at the start, was well placed behind the dueling leaders, saved ground on the turn, was asked to pursue the leader near the five-sixteenths pole but came up empty. MISS BETTE M broke outward and bumped with a rival, dueled on the outside of the winner, drifted three

wide leaving the turn and stopped abruptly. (Rail at 18 Feet)
