Footnotes

JULIE'S INA FRENZY one of the lucky few to get away cleanly, contested the pace three wide with another pair of opponents, continued the battle during the run around the bend, shook free nearing the quarter pole, by now having been put to encouragement, lengthened the lead during the ensuing furlong, then held sway while being kept to the task at hand. BY M K was knocked off balance after bumping hard with MISS BECKY at the start, was unhurried during the early stages while racing along the outside, picked up the pace under some encouragement upon reaching the turn, swung three to four wide into the stretch, took a few strides before settling into her rally, made steady progress, then closed in with even more interest after the rider switched to flashing the whip from the right side leaving the sixteenth pole. SONG OF BROADWAY was knocked sideways after being bumped at the start, assumed a forward position nonetheless, sat perched three to four wide off the pace dispute, moved up from midway on the turn under her own power, was asked for more turning for home, narrowed in on the leader, before flattening out a bit during the final furlong. SILVER CITY DREAMS was bumped soundly just after the start, rode the rail before being guided outward at the half mile, bumped with DIXIE ROCKS shortly afterwards, swung five wide into the stretch, but had no solid stretch offering. BIRD IN HAND bumped between rivals at the start, brought up the rear of the pack while taking the inside, advanced past weakening rivals while continuing along the rail on the turn, angled out after turning for home, and managed to further improve position. TURN THAT PAIGE broke outward, bumping soundly with MISS BECKY, as a consequence, went on with it to vie with a pair of rivals while racing towards the inside, gave way after reaching the quarter pole. DI COLAS OFFICER away in good order, was allowed to drop back off the developing pace skirmish, tracked the tussling threesome from the rail, being mildly urged along to keep pace, backed off after going a half. DIXIE ROCKS bumped at the start and just past the half mile pole, raced off the inside and folded. SHE'S AN OUTLAW came out of the gate in good shape, argued the pace from between rivals for nearly a half and faltered. WIND IN MY SAILS bumped between rivals at the start, was through after going a half. MISS BECKY jostled at the break, displayed only brief foot.
