Footnotes

LUBASH went straight to the lead, contested the pace on the inside, shook off intermittent challenges when asked leaving the far turn, drew off in upper stretch, was set down passing the furlong marker and held sway under steady handling. SEATTLE MISSION was reserved while off the rail, dropped to the rail early on the far turn, angled back out near the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch, lugged inward in the drive and closed gradually but failed to reach the winner. ZEALOUS BOY was rated on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, shifted three wide and was roused approaching the quarter-pole, was carried in by SEATTLE MISSION in the stretch and weakened while clear for the show. ADIRONDACK WARRIOR dropped to the back in the early going, was unhurried while off the rail, split rivals coming to the quarter-pole and improved position. GOOD TO BE ME contested the pace on the outside of the winner, lost touch with that rival entering the stretch and tired. LEATHERHEAD settled towards the rear of the field while off the rail, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. PARKINSON FIELD was reserved on the inside, steadied slightly when SEATTLE MISSION dropped in near the three-eighths pole, saved ground into the stretch and failed to respond. GASPER C. broke in the air and was off slow, moved up into the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, came four wide onto the backstretch, was forwardly placed on the outside, dropped to one off the rail on the far turn, drifted four wide nearing the quarter-pole and stopped.
