Footnotes

TRANQUIL MANNER taken hold of soon after leaving the starting gate, was unhurried while racing along the inside, continued to bide his time until midway on the far turn, began his advancement into contention after being asked for run, angled sharply three wide into the lane, gained readily during the run through the furlong grounds, maintained the momentum to draw alongside the leader past the sixteenth pole, went by in short order and edged clear, driving. BIRD RUN bumped at the start, was guided over to the inside during the straightaway approach leading to the opening bend, set the fractions on a loosely-contested lead towards the inside and with the rider applying rating tactics, bounded along on the far turn under similar conditions, was put to encouragement as a rival geared up to make his bid for the lead, raced head to head with ATOMIC RAIN after turning for home, bumping lightly with that foe in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, shook free with an eighth pole, felt the top one's presence by deep stretch, offered little resistance, readily yielding, and had to settle for being second best. ATOMIC RAIN, bumped at the start, was steadied early when BIRD RUN crossed over to the inside, tracked the well rated pacesetter from the rail, squeezed outward at the three-furlongs pole, prior to making a bid for the lead, ranged up, having been roused since the five-sixteenths pole, was on nearly even terms with the leader, when bumped lightly by that one in upper stretch, kept pace until the furlong marker and steadily tired. EYE OF THE LEOPARD bumped at the start, raced widest on both turns and folded. SENIORS PRIDE bumped between rivals at the start, attended the pace from the outside under a good hold for six furlongs before giving way.
