INDIAN TALE settled well behind the leading duo while on the outside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied under right hand urging in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker, closed well to get the lead around the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under a strong hand ride. SHARP TONGUE LADY bumped with HENNY'S HURRICANE at the start, moved up to take the lead, set the pace under mild pressure, vied inside on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, held a clear lead into the final furlong, was collared near the sixteenth-pole then proved no match while clear for the place. HENNY'S HURRICANE bumped with SHARP TONGUE LADY at the start, settled on the inside of INDIAN TALE, saved ground on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left handed whip at the top of the stretch and failed to rally while best of the rest. QUEEN'S HARBOR was rated on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip outside the quarter-pole, chased into the stretch and came up empty.
