STORMIN BUD put to light hand encouragement kicked clear of a tightly bunched group to grab early control, vied for the lead, placed slightly off the inside, was let out a notch in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, as the pressure from the closest pursuers began to intensify, drifted outward a couple of paths from left handed pressure midstretch, brushing with HILLSWICK and carrying out that opponent as the runner up was commencing to rally in earnest from along the rail, got overtaken soon afterwards, continued onward, regained the lead in deep stretch and dug in stubbornly and under good handling to preserve the decision. LAW ENFORCEMENT was unhurried in the early going while racing along the outside, ducked over to the rail after another had vacated the premises in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, was given some rein and accelerated past many of those who had chosen a wider route into the stretch to reach contention, altered course outward just past the three-sixteenths pole, but had no sooner done so when her newly chosen path got shut down by the drifting embattled pair just up ahead, saw a more promising route along the rail and altered course a second time to avail of the opportunity, wrestled away from the lead as the front runners brushed and continued to make their way towards the middle of the strip, attempted to stave off the eventual winner when once more on even terms in deep stretch, got outfinished late and had to settle for the place. MANNINGTON four wide at the three-eighths pole, was strung out in the five path, the widest of all, at the head of the stretch, displayed strong late foot to grab the show. HILLSWICK outward a bit leaving the starting gate, was grabbed hold and yanked off the nearest foe before contact could be made, disputed the pace outside the top one, gradually narrowed the gap during the run through the furlong grounds, brushed with and got carried out a couple of paths in the vicinity of the eighth pole, fought well but weakened late. RADIOHEAD (GB) bobbed at the start, was placed in the three path by the five-sixteenths pole in preparation for the stretch run, was set down after settling into upper stretch, lacked the necessary response. LEAVENWORTH urged from the get-go, was eased off the inside midway on the turn, turned for home three wide and was set down, was still within striking distance when forced by an errant twosome to alter course towards the rail with about a sixteenth to go, searched in vain, never able to find sufficient racing clearance thereafter to resume her bid. A claim of foul lodged by the rider of LAW ENFORCEMENT against the rider of STORMIN BUD alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
