Footnotes

READ THE PROPOSAL was hustled to the lead, set the pace on the outside while under pressure, inched clear midway through the turn, responded well when set down after straightening for the drive, drifted out under a right-handed whip, drew off into the final furlong, was given one crack of a right-handed whip just inside the eighth-pole then proved much the best under a strong hand ride. SONG OF ASPEN dropped well behind while urged along, went three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, advanced past rivals while under the whip in upper stretch, moved into second passing the furlong marker and safely secured the place while under a strong hand ride. SUNLOVER was hustled from the start then well placed just off the pace, chased three wide on the turn, was given one crack of a left-handed whip outside the quarter-pole, continued under left hand urging in upper stretch and tired while best of the rest. DRIVENBYCHOCOLATE broke a bit slow then drifted in, was ridden along towards the inside, raced off the rail while under the whip on the turn and came up empty. CAPTAIN GAUGHEN settled on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip near the five-sixteenths pole, continued under right hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker and capitulated. MAD WITH FEVER broke in but was quickly corrected by the rider, showed good speed, pressed the leader on the inside, vied along the rail early on the turn, dropped out near the three-eighths pole and faded. FLATTERMEWITHROSES sat back at the start, broke about two lengths behind the field, moved up while urged along, was taken in hand very briefly outside the half-mile pole, went three wide early on the turn then dropped to the inside, saved ground into the stretch, angled to the outside and failed to respond.
