MAJESTIC HUSSAR showed good natural speed on the outside, stalked the dueling leaders, ranged up while three to four wide on the turn, took the advantage outside the quarter-pole with the rider motionless in the saddle, edged clear while given the slightest movement of the hands by the rider, extended the advantage into the final furlong and drew off with the greatest of ease to win handily. CASINO DAY was fractious in the gate, broke out and bumped with AIR SQUADRON, was urged along towards the rear, advanced three to four wide on the turn, was given one crack of a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter and safely secured the place. ITHASTOBEGEORGE dueled on the inside of RUGGED, vied along the rail on the turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out some in upper stretch and tired while able to get the show. AIR SQUADRON bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along while off the pace, raced inside early on the turn, came under the whip, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, shifted out under left hand urging after straightening for the drive, was switched to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and failed to rally. OVERWHELMING broke a bit slow, was urged along at the rear, raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. HOTTER N BLAZES chased the pace from fourth, raced two to three wide on the turn and weakened. RUGGED came away in good order, dueled on the outside, was asked for more when joined by the winner at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped out entering the stretch and stopped.
