BILL OF RIGHTS away well, established the front along the inside in hand, marshaled the field down the backside under no pressure, began to widen away near the five-sixteenths, got roused at the head of the lane coming just off the inside, went clear under a drive, had the rider sneak a peak back and was geared down through the final sixteenth to prevail comfortably. PYRO CITY bumped from both sides at the start, settled within aim of the leader just off the inside under a firm hold, came under encouragement as that foe scampered away at the five-sixteenths, cornered two to three wide into the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the place honors. ALL ALEX two to three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing between foes at the seven-sixteenths, was fully engaged by the rider at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid then surged late to garner the show. DISCREET CODE tracked the pace along the inside from striking range, got set down at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch, kept on mildly before weakening in the late stages. MY PAL OF PALS bumped at the start by EL CORRIENTE and squeezed back against PYRO CITY, saved ground at the rear of the field, cornered in hand two to three wide for home and passed tired rivals in the stretch under very tepid and sporadic encouragement to the wire. YOU TARZAN broke in at the start bumping PYRO CITY before being corrected, settled two to three wide towards the rear, commenced a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and offered no kick. CASH YOUR TICKET carried out four wide into the first turn by ANTONE SUAVEY who cornered a bit unfocused early on, settled three to four wide in mid pack down the backside, commenced a four wide drive three furlongs out, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and offered no rally. EL CORRIENTE a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke out bumping MY PAL OF PALS against PYRO CITY and squeezing that foe back, saved ground towards the rear, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, offered little and tired in the drive. ANTONE SUAVEY forwardly placed from the start, drifted four wide into the first turn carrying out CASH YOUR TICKET briefly, raced three to four wide within aim of the front, came under coaxing nearing the seven-sixteenths, retreated through the far turn and tired in the stretch.
