FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the close of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a Graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2013. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 27, 2013 with 23 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

**Footnotes**

CORFU showed good speed, set the pace through fast fractions, controlled the action while inside on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, clung to a length lead into the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, leaned on WIRED BRYAN when that rival drew alongside late, rubbed saddles with that opponent while under continued left-hand urging and desperately prevailed in a game effort. WIRED BRYAN came in early, chased the pace on the outside through the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, pursued the winner into the final furlong, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, inched alongside CORFU late, rubbed saddles with that opponent nearing the wire and just missed. DANZA was urged along on the outside, raced off the rail on the turn, dropped to the inside after straightening into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, remained well back into the final furlong and finished fast but was too late while able to garner the show. LUNARWARFARE jostled with a rival after the start and was forced in, raced on the inside while ridden along, saved ground on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, pursued the top two under a drive into the final furlong and finished willingly. CANDY DANDY bumped with a rival after the start, was well placed in third position, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail while under urging, shifted three wide into the stretch, came under the whip and capitulated. OGERMEISTER bobbled slightly at the start then bumped with CANDY DANDY, threw his head while racing a bit erratic in the early going, raced at the rear of the field while off the rail, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole while under strong urging, came five wide into the stretch, drifted in under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. TWANG settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, hesitated when LUNARWARFARE came out at that point and had nothing left.
