SWEET WHISKEY came away in good order, showed good natural speed then easily moved clear, dictated terms while off the rail through the turn, extended the advantage under a brisk hand ride in upper stretch and proved much the best under continued strong hand urging to the wire. KNACQUE came in just after the start, settled on the inside, saved ground while urged along on the turn, came out in upper stretch while under a right-handed whip and secured the place while no match for the winner. TEA TIME was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide while under a strong ride on the turn, came under a left-handed whip near the furlong marker while a bit green, switched to a right-handed whip at the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. RADIANT broke near the back of the field, was coaxed along on the outside, went five wide while under stronger urging on the turn and weakened. DIVIDED ATTENTION was ridden along towards the back, saved ground on the turn, moved out inside the furlong marker and failed to respond. CLEVER BEAUTY broke in a bit at the start, was hard ridden while off the pace, went three then two wide on the turn, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and was no factor. WALK OF STARS was hustled from the start, chased the pace, shifted out outside the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn and tired. CHIEF DANTE leaned in at the start, brushed the inside of the gate and was last away, raced towards the rear while urged along, entered the turn four wide, lugged out six wide near the seven-sixteenths pole, continued six wide through the middle of the turn, dropped to four wide around the quarter-pole and failed to threaten.
