TEEN PAULINE broke evenly with HAPPY FACE, raced side by side with that opponent for a while being getting eased back, patiently prompted that foe from the two path, drew abreast leaving the midway point on the second bend, poked a head down in front spinning into the stretch then got called upon, drew out to her biggest advantage after completing the ensuing furlong, dug in well while drifting over to the rail in the late stages, with only a couple of light taps interrupting a vigorous hand ride. YES IT'S PINK was grabbed hold after coming out a couple of steps at the break, saved ground until the quarter pole, angled out for the drive and got put to one, gained ground readily, split rivals with an eighth to go en route to garnering the place. SENSE TO COMPETE bumped from both sides at the start, settled into midpack, was unhurried for the opening three-quarters, got fanned four wide into upper stretch, finished willingly, missing out on place honors. DREAMING OF CARA made contact with SENSE TO COMPETE leaving the starting gate, darted over to the rail shortly afterwards and took the inside route on the opening bend, got tipped to the outside proceeding down the backstretch and stayed off the inside thereafter, entered the stretch and lacked a solid late response. NEITH forwardly placed three wide on both turns, was put to some encouragement and challenged in earnest turning for home, wasn't up to the task at hand and backed away. HAPPY FACE away alertly, raced as a team with the winner during the very earliest stages, was conceded the lead approaching the end of the homestretch, rated kindly from the rail under the watchful eye of TEEN PAULINE, had that opponent drew directly alongside after halfway around the far turn, was already under some hand urging relinquishing the lead, tired steadily. LADY CLARA bumped at the start, travelled in the three path on each bend, folded. SAMIAM tracked the front runners while loosely pocketed, was under some urging but not being asked for her best by the five-sixteenths marker, gave way.
