Footnotes

PARTLY MOCHA settled well back while under some urging, raced off the rail early on the turn, angled five wide nearing the quarter-pole, came six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside into the final furlong and closed strongly under a right-handed whip to get up late. JESS NOT JESSE was last to commence, moved up on the outside to race just off the pace, came under some urging while three then four wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled with ZIPTRONIC under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, gained the lead shortly thereafter, switched to a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and was denied in a good effort. ZIPTRONIC dueled on the outside then three wide on the turn, inched clear passing the five-sixteenths pole, drifted out some just after turning into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, lost the advantage leaving the furlong marker and weakened. MIDNIGHT MUSIC was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, steadied behind the tiring TEN ITEMS OR LESS at the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail to go around that rival near the quarter-pole, was asked for his best in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. RIP ROARIN RITCHIE was urged along while racing with his head high, went three then four wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole, chased in upper stretch and tired. I'M WIDE AWAKE was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, drifted inward in uppers stretch, moved out near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed response. PASS THE PICO dropped back while climbing a bit early, raced well back in the field, saved ground early on the turn, came off the rail before the quarter-pole and was no factor while not really handling the surface. STONELY THE LONELY was coaxed along

while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to rally. TEN ITEMS OR LESS dueled on the inside of a rival while off the rail, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to the rail near the quarter-pole and faded. (Rail at 18 Feet)
