NEGOTIATOR, hustled along early, came wide for the drive and closed determinedly to be along in the late stages. DASH FOR DAYLIGHT, close up inside, angled out in upper stretch, led between calls in deep stretch but could not contain the winner. KING'S QUEST quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and weakened in the final furlong. NEVADA STRIP, hustled outside, put in a run between rivals nearing the stretch and weakened late. ABSAROKA, close up outside, put in a three wide run on the turn but had little left for the stretch drive. HOLY TOLEDO broke awkwardly, was hustled inside and lacked a rally. STOKES, hustled outside, raced three wide and tired. MT. BELLEWOOD broke slowly and raced four wide. SWEET RIDE was hustled inside but had no response. TOURNAMENT PLAY raced inside and tired badly.
