COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun early, came widest into the stretch, finished gamely from the outside and was along late, driving. POLISH MINER raced close up in hand, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, drew clear in midstretch and stayed on gamely but could not resist the winner. PICKUPSPEED was outrun early, rallied five wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely despite being steadied in deep stretch. JUDGE'S CASE was rated along inside and had no rally. POSTPONED contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. ABOVE THE CROWD contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SAINT JOSEPH raced wide throughout and tired. REGAL SHIVERS was steadied along the inside entering the first turn, contested the pace while between rivals and tired after three quarters.
