Footnotes

DAWN CHORUS raced up close along the rail, waited while saving ground on the turn, split horses entering the stretch, made a run to challenge inside the furlong marker and prevailed under steady right hand urging. WEST OCEAN raced in the middle of the pack between horses for a half, circled six wide into the stretch and finished well in the middle of the track. RIDE ON JOSEPHINE stalked outside lodged a four wide move at the quarter pole and finished willingly to gain a share. CHICK IN SLACKS was outrun for a half along the inside, drifted out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. SOUTHERN DYNASTY set the pace on the rail into midstretch and weakened. DIXIE PIXIE raced inside into upper stretch and was caught in traffic along the rail late. SHE'S ABOVE DA LAW raced wide leaving the turn after breaking slowly. BUT FOR MONEY checked in traffic early, drifted out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. CORBINA pressed the pace in the two path and gave way in upper stretch.
