TAHOE WARRIOR pressed the early pace from outside, dropped back slightly on the far turn, split horses on the turn and closed steadily to prevail after a long drive. BIGGERBADDERBETTER saved ground just off the pace to the turn, waited briefly and angled out entering the stretch then closed late after splitting horses in deep stretch to gain the place. COBRADOR raced just off the pace for a half, rallied three wide to challenge on the turn, battled into midstretch and yielded late. DANCING TIN MAN raced in midpack while saving ground into upper stretch and raced in traffic through the stretch. FAIRWAY DRIVE raced inside to the turn, angled out midway on the turn, swung four wide while splitting horses entering the stretch then finished willingly through the final sixteenth. LEMON SHORE set the pace on the rail into midstretch and tired. CLIFF MEADOWS clipped heels and stumbled soon after the start, was outrun for five furlongs, checked in traffic on the far turn, swung five wide entering the stretch and failed to threaten with a mild late rally. DEPUTYVILLE was never a factor. ELDOKTORI steadied and clipped heels at the seven-eighths pole, raced between horses while four wide and finished evenly. KRIS ANGEL

trailed throughout.
