LEAD US NOT quickly established command, showed the way towards the inside under a firm hold until nearing the sixth hurdle, readily yielded, content to track the new leader while remaining along the inside route, lost a bit of ground as that rival edged away around the final bend, altered course to the outside in upper stretch before being called upon, closed in after being straightened away, came back successfully to reach even terms in deep stretch and edged clear under a drive. PARKER'S PROJECT underwent a wide journey and finished with good courage to garner place honors. GRANTOR content to lag behind while saving ground, displayed a good kick to earn the show. RIDDLE patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, well rated, until leaving the third turn, advanced readily to take charge upon reaching the sixth jump, edged away after being let out a notch during the run around the final bend, was still in front as the field approached the final barrier, with several rivals by now in hot pursuit, weakened steadily during the final furlong. SALUDA SAM raced along the inside, was rank at various points, stubbornly resisting the rating tactics being applied by the rider, came up empty for the stretch run. CHESS BOARD (GB) well placed along the outside, tired. HIDDEN TRAIL saved ground, left the course nearing the ninth and was vanned off. ALL TOGETHER forwardly placed outside, gave way and left the course at the ninth jump. EASY RED failed to reach a contending position, and left the course approaching the final jump.
