Footnotes

HERITAGE HALL away well, dropped back steadily during the run down the backstretch, was asked to pick up the pace departing the half mile pole, but failed to gain ground appreciably, was set down swinging into the stretch, winding up about five to six wide at the head of the stretch, took off in earnest after the front runners, was carried out a bit midstretch, the result of GOOD KARMA angling outward, continued onward, having lost little if any momentum from that incident, then finding his best stride leaving the sixteenth pole, closed with a rush to grab the lead, despite brushing with a rival, just prior to the finish line to prove best. HARMONIZER well positioned along the outside behind a three way pace battle, was roused coming to the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward more to the middle of the strip soon after settling into the lane, narrowed in on the leader, shadowed a drifting STAR OF NEW YORK to the middle of the track during the run through the furlong grounds, brushed with that foe midstretch, continued his pursuit relentlessly, grabbed the lead deep stretch briefly, wasn't able to stave off the top one when that foe arrived on the scene, but continued on with good courage to grab second, despite bumping a second time with the show horse, a couple of strides before the wire. STAR OF NEW YORK battled with a pair of rivals from the three path, drifted outward, resisting right handed pressure all the while before forging to the front at the eighth pole, continued to come out, brushing with the runner up soon after departing the furlong grounds, dug in stubbornly, before yielding, then bumped with HARMONIZER for the second time, just before the end. GOOD KARMA unhurried for nearly a half, cut the corner to reach a good striking distance, angled outward in upper stretch, after spotting some potential traffic problems up ahead, came home willingly to earn the last major share. HENCEFORTH saved ground while battling a duo for the lead, gave way during the final furlong. NUMB LIPS took the inside route, angled sharply three wide into the stretch, but failed to muster up the needed stretch response. GREEN BANANAS contested the pace between rivals for a half and faded.
