**Footnotes**

GREAT CRUSADE away from the gate in good order, contested the pace from the two path, with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, kept the pressure on ALWAYS ON THE MOVE throughout the run around second bend, was put to encouragement swinging into the lane, forged to the front nearing the eighth pole, then drew clear in the last eighth, driving. SHOTGUN BANDIT contently tracked the frontrunners from the inside, maneuvered off the rail turning for home, took off in earnest when set down, altered course to the inside at the eighth pole, split rivals to loom boldly, but proved no match for the top one thereafter, while well clear of the remainder for place honors. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE raced three wide around the turn, swung three to four wide into the lane while in the midst of his rally, and displayed a mild kick to be along for the show. FIERY REBEL saved ground, angled three wide after turning for home, lacked the necessary stretch response. MEL'S GOLD within range along the outside, was asked for run at the five-sixteenth pole, weakened during the final eighth. ALWAYS ON THE MOVE vied for the lead towards the inside, remained a prominent factor until midstretch and gave way. ADMIRALTY off the inside, had no solid stretch response. WHEELSAREOFFTHEBUS three wide, never threatened. BATON ROUGE stumbled badly at

the break, under a three wide pursuit and tired after going a half. PIANO STAR was guided over to the inside midway down the backstretch, underwent a ground-saving ground from there and faded.
