EVER A FRIEND raced towards the inside on the first turn, settled outside at the back of the field, was asked near the seven-sixteenths pole, circled three then four wide on the far turn, moved to five wide outside the quarter-pole, closed well to make a bid in upper stretch, battled with GLACIER BAY in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under mostly strong hand urging. GLACIER BAY was reserved while towards the inside on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field on the backstretch, was asked while off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, made a bid between rivals in upper stretch, battled with EVER A FRIEND in the final furlong and just missed. PARC DES PRINCES (BRZ) raced three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, was asked to pursue that rival near the five-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead inside the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the show. ALMORADI (IRE) raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked approaching the quarter-pole, made a bid between rivals in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong and was also outfinished then just missed the show. THE VIN MAN broke out at the start, was reserved on the inside, bided his time on the far turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, was asked for run, swung out at the top of the stretch, came under a drive and finished willingly while improving position. CITY SNEAKERS went to the early lead, set the pace on the inside through solid fractions, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead around the three-sixteenths pole and gave way. MANCHILD moved in before the first turn, dropped to the rail midway through that turn, was rated on the inside, came under urging near the

five-sixteenths pole, was put to a left-handed whip and weakened. BOLD VINDICATION bumped with WAYWARDVILLE in the early going, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. WAYWARDWILLIE bumped with BOLD VINDICATION in the early going, was rank into the first turn, raced towards the back while under restraint, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and also failed to respond.
