



ROTHKO bumped with DEED IT IS at the start, settled on the outside while in fourth position, went three wide on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, made a bid in upper stretch, gained the lead nearing the furlong marker, was given one crack of a left-handed whip then edged clear under hand urging. SEA SONG'S HAMMER chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, gained a short lead, lost the lead nearing the eighth-pole, was put to a left-handed whip and was outfinished while able to get the place. PERFECT SLAM (BRZ) was well placed just off the pace, chased inside on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong, was put to the whip and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. SOULTOWN settled off the pace, was a bit green leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail while urged along on the turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. DEED IT IS bumped with ROTHKO at the start, was ridden along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, swung five wide at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. SHOW ME THE WAY was hustled to the lead, set the clear pace, controlled the action while inside early on the turn, drifted off the rail approaching the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back to the inside, came under the whip nearing the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired. LAST HURRAH came out at the start, showed no speed, dropped well behind the field, moved out in upper stretch and was no factor. PLYMOUTH SQUARE was taken up briefly while in tight after the start, raced off the pace while urged along, saved ground on the turn and came up empty.
