BIG BLUE KITTEN away well tucked along the inside soon after the start, rated kindly while tracking the pacesetter, continued along on the same scenario for nearly three-quarters, began to pick up interest and speed late on the far turn, was already under encouragement entering the stretch, gained a clear alleyway along the inside as the pacesetter drifting out slightly, launched a rail rally and was driven to a clear advantage with an eighth to go, continued on with good determination to hold sway, kept busy to the end. PERREGAUX contently rode the rail, was eased off the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung from the outside into the lane and got called upon, failed to pick up ground appreciably during the initial portion of the stretch drive, left the sixteenth pole and proceeded to display strong late foot to garner place honors. HUMBLE AND HUNGRY was rank during the straightaway approach leading up to the opening bend, settled down and acted more professionally upon reaching the backstretch, appeared to take a bad step near midpoint, resumed stalking the leader, was let out a notch early on the second turn to maintain a good striking position during the run around the far turn, was given his cue and bid in earnest spinning into the lane, got out finished. RUSTLER HUSTLER quickly established control, cut the pace while being rated along, slightly off the inside, was asked for run turning for home as the closest pursuers prepared for their challenges, yielded just prior to reaching the furlong marker and steadily weakened thereafter. CRIMSON CHINA unhurried along the inside, was asked for some run in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got placed five wide at the head of the stretch and went on to improve position. BENERGY saved ground until the quarter pole. STREET GAME strung out in the three path for each of the bends, bid mildly from the three-eighths pole, but soon flattened out.
