Footnotes

BEAR HEART brushed with a rival after the start, was well placed just off the pace, drafted behind the leader while near the inside on the turn, was guided out behind the top two in upper stretch, rallied on the outside under a confident hand ride and got up late. COUNT CATAMOUNT tracked the leader, made a bid at the top of the stretch, was asked near the three-sixteenths pole, held the lead into the final sixteenth but was denied while clear for the place. RETIRE TO WHAT was hustled to the lead, set the pace through reasonable fractions, vied inside on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to hold the show. MITIGATION was reserved on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and improved position. SAINTS ALIVE was forwardly placed on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was asked around the five-sixteenths pole, chased in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. CORONATION DAY settled at the back of the field, shifted out behind rivals leaving the backstretch, went three then four wide on the turn and also improved position. MOR CHANCES settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came off the rail in upper stretch and failed to rally. KINGSDALE OCEAN (IRE) brushed with a rival after the start, settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn, moved out once straightened for

the drive and also failed to rally. SYSTEM RESTORE was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. RUSSIAN SAGE broke a bit awkwardly but with the field, settled while off the rail, was asked coming to the quarter-pole and came up empty. (Rail at 18 Feet)
