FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken their maiden in a race at the Aqueduct spring or Belmont spring/summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a Graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2012. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs. A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 28, 2012 with 25 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

KAUAI KATIE quickly established control, pulled on the bit from the left side but otherwise proved ratable, made it to the quarter pole with none having been latched on, was given her cue entering the stretch and responded positively, scampered away from the competition to emerge from the furlong grounds in possession of her biggest advantage, maintained it, crossing the finish line under a hand drive. SALAMERA underwent a three wide pursuit, was let out a notch departing the backstretch and narrowed in on the winner, got as far as just off that one's hind quarters but no further, fell back during the run through the furlong grounds when unable to keep pace, but continued onward willingly to secure second. FULLY LIVING tracked the pacesetter while taking the inside route, fought against bit while doing so for much of the way towards the half mile pole, paused in hand coming to the five-sixteenths pole before angling outward, commenced the drive from the three path, got outkicked. CAYLLANO was sent over to the inside coming to the of the backstretch, stayed there until about midway on the turn, leaving the three-eighths pole back in the two path, failed to fire when called upon in upper stretch. VITAMETA acted up in the starting gate prior to the start, proceeded to break outward a step and was grabbed hold by the pilot, chased the winner from off the inside until the quarter pole before backing away.
