All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken their maiden in a race at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 which will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a Graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2012. 122 lbs. SPURIOUS PRECISION was away alertly, set the pace through blistering fractions while under pressure, vied a bit off the rail early on the turn then on the inside, was asked for more passing the five-sixteenths pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, disposed of DRUM ROLL outside the furlong marker, drew off under continued right hand urging then was eased up late while much the best. HE'S SO FINE was ridden along at the rear, raced three wide while under the whip on the turn, gained some ground in upper stretch, came between rivals late and got up for the place. IN HARM'S WAY was last away, raced well off the pace while urged along, went two then three wide on the turn, came under a left-handed whip at the quarter-pole, switched to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker and narrowly earned the show. DRUM ROLL chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, lost touch with the winner outside the furlong marker and tired then drifted out late and was caught for the show. SOUTHERN HONOR came out a bit at the start then was corrected by the rider, showed good speed, pressed the fast pace on the outside, vied between rivals late on the turn, dropped out nearing the quarter-pole and weakened. DAN THE TIN MAN moved in near the five-eighths pole while just off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the turn and stopped then was put under a protective hold late.
