Footnotes

POLITICAL JUSTICE quickly established control, was angled over sharply towards the inside, tucking along the rail just before reaching the opening bend, was well rated on an open lead, and remained so until the quarter pole, got called upon departing that station, maintained a healthy margin to the end. IMPERIAL ROBYN chased the winner from along the outside, lacked the necessary response to reel that opponent in, then held on well enough long enough to salvage second. DECIPHERING DREAMS was placed into the two path coming to the half mile pole, went on another eighth before being set down a drive, displayed a mild kick while missing out on place honors. RED JACK three wide around both turns, tired. ELDER SKATESMAN off a beat slowly, loped along for the initial three-quarters, altered course to be widest of all at the three-sixteenths pole, came up empty. QUICK RECOVERY was steadied when briefly put in tight quarters approaching the first turn, got taken over to the rail at the half mile, faded steadily after completing six furlongs.
