KITTEN'S DUMPLINGS was bumped hard after the start, bumped hard with ATLANTIC DREAM early, was reserved towards the back while off the inside, circled four to five wide on the far turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong, was given two reminders with a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole then proved best under an energetic hand ride. GUSTAVIA was bumped at the start then shut-off and dropped back, raced inside while under restraint on the first turn, was reserved at the back, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip and finished willingly for the place. OSCAR PARTY lunged at the break but broke with the field, went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace while on the outside, inched closer while three wide on the far turn, made a bid while one off the rail entering the stretch, battled under a drive and was outfinished then just missed the show. ATLANTIC DREAM brushed with a rival after the start, bumped hard with KITTEN'S DUMPLINGS early, saved ground on the first turn, was reserved near the back, waited on hold while stuck behind traffic on the far turn, was asked then driven four wide outside the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, shield outward near the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip and improved position. THREE HEARTS bobbled at the start, bumped hard with ALLURING LADY early, dropped near the inside late on the first turn, was rated while off the rail on the backstretch, waited on the far turn, was given her cue outside the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. PSYCHADELACIZED went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, dropped back under a right-handed whip and gave way. GIANT CATS EYE bumped with a rival at the start then veered in and bumped hard with another rival, was reserved off the pace while between rivals most of the way, brushed with ALLURING LADY leaving the backstretch, moved closer while in traffic on the final bend, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, hesitated between horses outside the quarter-pole, lugged in after straightening for the drive, was put to a left-handed whip and came up empty.

ALLURING LADY bumped hard with THREE HEARTS in the early going, fought the rider while rank and inside on the first turn, lost position while doing so, was reserved under restraint, brushed with GIANT CATS EYE leaving the backstretch, waited behind a wall of horses on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. MINNIE BEAR was eager in the early going, went three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the top of the stretch, lost touch with the winner while under the whip and weakened. NEITH contested the pace on the inside, dropped back under urging on the far turn, was taken in hand while turning the corner and faded.
