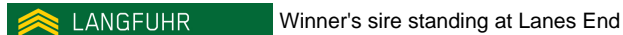

Footnotes

FRUTTIDIMARE just off the inside midpack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into upper stretch progressing on the leaders to the eighth pole, bumped with APPEALETTA at that station, continued to bump lightly with that rival to the sixteenth marker before inching away at that station under a drive to prevail. APPEALETTA prompted the pace two to three wide, cornered four wide for home, displaced the pace maker nearing the eighth pole, got bumped at that juncture and was herself upended on the front soon after that station, fought on trading light brushes and bumps to the sixteenth pole before yielding some fight while holding safely for place honors. ANCHOVY just off the pace in the three path, was placed to drive shortly after midway on the turn, spun six wide at the quarter pole, offered up a mild kick late on for the show. CARROT THIEF saved ground throughout towards the rear, got spirited up at the five-sixteenths, shifted off the rail at the three-sixteenths, offered up a mild bid for the last major share. ESTHERS CLASSY LAS urged along on the front showing the way from just off the inside while prompted, was displaced nearing the final furlong, kept on a sixteenth down the

road before weakening late on. OUTLAW CODY Z two to three wide in midpack, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole and passed tired rivals in the stretch. SHEILA'S GOLD came in sharply at the start, bumping SIGNORA SOFIA soundly and squeezing that foe back between rivals against MEGHAN'S FURY as APPEALETTA escaped the brunt of it by out breaking that trio, chased four wide under a good near side hold as she appeared to be trying to get out in the turn, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, spun three wide at the quarter pole and tired. MEGHAN'S FURY taken in hand briefly when bumped at the start, a product of SHEILA'S GOLD coming in, raced towards the rear just off the inside, was three wide turning for home and offered no response. SIGNORA SOFIA bumped soundly at the start by SHEILA'S GOLD, was taken in hand as a result, chased three wide towards the rear, came under urging at the three-eighths pole and made no impact. TOUCH OF ROYALTY three wide in midpack, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, offered no kick backing out steadily through the turn and was eased nearing the eighth pole.
