### Footnotes

MARTINI MADNESS was restless in the gate, came away in good order, disputed the pace on the inside of INFLATION TARGET while off the rail, vied off the inside on the turn, moved clear near the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when asked after turning into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and held well while drifting out late under continued right-hand urging. TUMMEL settled on the outside, was coaxed along while four wide on the turn, moved closer near the five-sixteenths, came under a drive in upper stretch, chased the winner under a left-handed whip and finished willingly while second best. EQUIVOCATION settled in the early going, angled in near the three-quarter pole, moved up with five furlongs to run, was urged along while off the rail on the turn, needed a little pull of the left-rein to negotiate the bend, dropped to the inside at the quarter-pole, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. DAN AND SHEILA was hustled from the start then ridden along on the outside, went three wide while hard ridden on the turn, came four wide into the stretch while under the whip and failed to rally then missed the show. INFLATION TARGET disputed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the stretch and tired.
