Footnotes

EDIE away in goof order took up the role of primary pursuer, was patiently handled stalking the pacesetter for nearly six furlongs, ranged up when ready and drew alongside strides before the third fraction was being recorded, got called upon for the stretch and quickly shook free, bobbed in full stride over a chewed-up portion of the course in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole while drawing off. TOWN FLIRT got away slowly, after making solid contact with right side of the starting gate, raced at least three wide around both turns, was under solid encouragement taking the four path for entrance into the stretch, proved no match for the top one but mustered up good courage nonetheless to procure the place. CHICK IN SLACKS tracked the front runners, angled off the inside route for the stretch, got outfinished. FAVA strung out three wide on the opening bend, continued to race from off the inside thereafter, but closer to the rail, proceeded around the far turn from between rivals, failed to give the needed response once called upon. BEAUTIFUL RISK three wide until the quarter pole, rallied mildly to mainly improve position. SURPRISE SQUALL saved ground until midway down the backstretch, was taken hold after

approaching the heels of MESS IN A DRESS, dropped back position-wise, tipped into the two path, continued unhurried for the initial six furlongs, displayed an increase in interest after getting cued up at the five-sixteenths pole, angled sharply five wide into the stretch, failed to make headway, then was vanned off after the finish. G. A. EMPRESS stumbled at the start, swung three wide into the backstretch and remained at a considerable distance from off the rail thereafter, was four wide at the five-sixteenths pole and in the five path for the start of the stretch run, made no impact. MESS IN A DRESS saved ground until the quarter pole, was forced to remain on hold approaching the quarter pole, found enough room to angle outward shortly after entering the stretch, came up empty. GLAMOUR GALORE cleared the field under her own power and was guided over to the rail, was rated along on a loosely-contested lead until midpoint on the second bend, felt a definite increase in the pressure at that point and was asked for run, yielded but remained a prominent factor until midlane before backing away.
