BEER IS GOOD was fractious in the gate, came away in good order, chased the pace on the outside, went two to three wide early on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, took the lead on the outside, inched clear into the final furlong and was fully extended to last under a right-handed whip. VOLCANO RUN was ridden along towards the back, raced inside early on the turn, came off the rail late on the bend, swung four wide into the stretch, moved a bit further to the outside shortly thereafter, rallied in the final furlong under a right-handed whip and closed strongly to just miss. RADIOHEAD (GB) was urged along in the middle of the field, chased four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, pursued the winner under a right-handed whip and finished willingly for the show. SOKITUMI SAMURAI brushed with an opponent at the start, chased the pace on the inside of BEER IS GOOD, raced inside on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch, pursued the vanguard under a drive and lacked the needed kick. SANTO GATO showed good speed, disputed the pace on the inside of a rival while off the rail, dropped to the inside midway through the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, fought with the winner until almost the furlong marker then weakened. DON'T SAY NO bumped with a rival at the start then was slow into stride, settled towards the back while under some urging, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, shifted three wide late on the bend, swung six wide into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SPECIAL SELECTION bumped with an opponent at the start while breaking near the back, settled at the rear while under some urging, went two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide late on the bend, swung six wide into the stretch, moved in near the

three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. CROWN THE CHIEF disputed the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the turn, dropped out under a drive into the stretch and gave way. (Rail at 18 Feet)
