Footnotes

MONTAUK DAISY hesitated at the start, moved up along the inside, steadied while racing greenly at the half mile pole, angled out on the far turn, made a strong four wide move to take charge in upper stretch and drew under under right hand urging. ACCREDITING steadied in tight at the start, raced well back for a half, swung wide while gaining at the top of the stretch and finished well to clearly best the others. CARRS AND STRIPES was outrun for a half, worked her way forward five wide on the turn and closed late to gain a share. WHAT'S THAT MARNIE settled just off the early pace, made a four wide move to challenge on the far turn, battled heads apart to the top of the stretch, remained a factor into upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. DIXIELAND SQUALL set or forced the pace between horses for five furlongs and weakened. TODAY'S CHARMER up close early, drifted very wide on the turn and was never close thereafter. ATSA MY GIRL never reached contention. MY RODEO GAL raced in midpack along the inside and lacked a strong closing response. TRYTOSEEITMYWAY was never a factor. MAD ABOUT FONTAINE dueled on the rail for a half and gave way.
