Footnotes

HOMERETTE was unhurried for six furlongs while saving ground, launched a rally along the inside leaving the turn, rapidly gained in midstretch, split horses a sixteenth out and finished strongly to get up in the final twenty yards. WHATEVERWILLBILLB pressed the pace in the two path along the backstretch, surged to the front midway on the turn, battled for the lead into midstretch, fought heads apart into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. LATITUDE FORTY broke outward causing crowding at the start, moved up along the inside, settled in good position while saving ground for six furlongs, angled three wide at the quarter pole, lodged a mild bid in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. FAIRYTALE STORY was bumped soundly and pinched back at the start, steadied sharply along the inside nearing the first turn, raced far back for six furlongs, swung five wide on the turn, angled in leaving the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. BABY GRAY sprinted clear early, set the pace along the rail into upper stretch, fought heads apart into midstretch and weakened. REWRITE bumped and pinched back at the start, raced in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, rallied four wide to reach contention at the top of the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. ITSNOTTHEMONEY bumped at the start, steadied in tight early then clipped heels and stumbled, and failed to threaten thereafter. NOW MORE THAN EVER raced up close while three wide into upper stretch and tired. KATS GOLDEN WAYS steadied in traffic on the first turn raced within striking distance between horses to the far turn and gave way. SHE'S EXCELLENT trailed throughout after breaking slowly.
