**Footnotes**

AIR SUPPORT three wide around the opening bend, assumed the role of stalker, continued along in that role, biding his time around the second turn, was asked for a response as the field headed for the top of the stretch, closed in on the leader, was in the process of grabbing the lead, when he started drifting out noticeably several paths, resisting the right handed pressure being applied by the rider, was expertly put back on a truer course soon afterwards, with several rivals in hot pursuit by this time, then dug in tenaciously to fend them off and preserve the decision. GRIGIO saved ground during the opening stages in a well-strung out field, worked his way off the rail by midpoint on the far turn, swung four wide into the lane while commencing his rally, lost none of the momentum after being straightened away, charged down the course relentlessly, reached even terms a couple of strides prior to the wire, but had to settle for place honors. EAST INDIES placed in tight quarters, attempted to savage WILLY PAY after being bumped, soon after the break, took the inside route before guided to the outside midpoint down the backstretch, remained unhurried until nearing the quarter pole, then came home with good energy during the stretch run en route for show honors. ROGUE ROMANCE within range throughout, raced four wide around the second turn, gained ground gradually after being called upon in the lane, and continued on willingly to earn the last major share.. WILLY PAY bumped twice shortly after the start, survived being savaged by EAST INDIES as well, raced unhurried along the outside, had already advanced readily into contention with a four wide move on the far turn, before ducking to the two path near the five-sixteenths pole, maintained the momentum after swinging into the lane, loomed boldly with an eighth to go, but was outkicked in the late stages. COCKEYED ROOSTER bumped after the start, showed the way during the initial stages while well off the inside, worked his way over towards the two path nearing the half mile, continued on the front until upper stretch and steadily tired thereafter. DERBY KITTEN hesitated at the start and was always outrun. SURF CAST tracked the pacesetter from the inside for three-quarters and gave way. GOODTIMEHADBYALL saved ground to no avail.
