INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. Starters to receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs.; TURF: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake on the turf in 2010 allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 on the turf, 5 lbs., A sweepstake on the turf; or two races on the turf, 7 lbs. DIRT: Non-winners of a sweepstake at a mile or over on the dirt allowed 3 lbs.; two races at a mile or over on the dirt, 5 lbs.; two races, 7 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter or restricted allowance races not considered for turf and dirt). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track where dirt allowance weights will apply. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, July 31 with 27 Nominations.

Footnotes

INTERACTIF broke outward and hit the gate, settled off the rail on the first turn then outside on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, was asked to pick it up nearing the quarter-pole, accelerated once straightened for the drive, drew alongside the leader passing the eighth-pole, battled gamely with KRYPTON in the final furlong and narrowly defeated that rival and the fast closing GRAND RAPPORT under good handling. GRAND RAPPORT raced inside on the first turn, was reserved at the back of the compact field, commenced a rally while three wide on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, closed strongly on the outside and just missed. KRYPTON moved to the early lead, relinquished the lead early on the first turn, tracked PARIS VEGAS while well out in the course on the backstretch, moved closer nearing the far turn, was asked to go after the leader near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to a short lead entering the stretch, disposed of PARIS VEGAS but was immediately challenged by INTERACTIF, battled gamely with that rival in the final furlong and was denied in a three-way photo. NORDIC TRUCE was a bit rank while reserved off the rail, continued under a nice hold on the backstretch, waited while off the rail on the far turn, was roused coming to the quarter-pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong and finished willingly but lacked the needed kick. CITRUS KID settled on the inside, was roused midway through the far turn, saved ground into the stretch, came under vigorous urging near the three-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. PARIS VEGAS was hard held early, dragged his way to the lead early on the first turn, set a clear pace while under a hold on the inside, lost the lead leaving the far turn, failed to respond when asked to fight back and gave way. (Rail at 18 Feet)
