SPLINDID BEHAVIOR was bumped after bobbling at the start, prompted the hot fractions from the outside, was asked for a bit of run to remain within striking distance nearing the head of the stretch, took off in earnest when called for more, forged to the front during the run through the furlong grounds, then drew off while being kept to the task at hand. ACTIVE TRADER pursued the leader three to four wide around the bend, was put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole in attempt to close the gap, but failed to gain ground appreciably, proved no match for the top one leaving the furlong grounds, but mustered up enough to salvage the place. ARTIE'S CHAPTER was taken off a rival after breaking out a bit at the start, left the rail nearing the half mile pole, advanced forwardly from the outside around the turn, swung even wider into the lane, and rallied mildly to earn the show. CONSORT improved position by weak ones in the lane. JACK'S WORK urged on the turn, tired. HUMILARITY took control quickly after the gate sprung open, carved a hot pace while racing slightly off the rail, gave way in upper stretch. PAPERLESS ducked over to the inside at the half mile pole, tracked the leader while continuing to take the inside route, came up empty when called upon in the stretch. STROKE off slowly, was rushed up to rejoin the pack, raced four wide around the turn and tired. ZEN VILLAGE bumped at the start, bore out continuously from midway on the backstretch.
