QUALITY COUNCIL dueled on the inside of MYSTICISM, inched clear when asked for more at the top of the stretch, extended the advantage under strong hand urging, was put to a right-handed whip coming to the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under steady urging. WALL DANCE moved up some after the initial furlong, was well placed just off the pace, hesitated along the rail when AUGUST OSAGE came in, eased off the inside around the seven-sixteenths pole, drafted behind the leading duo nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was asked outside the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, shied from a right-handed whip passing the furlong marker, shied again from the whip nearing the sixteenth-pole and was second best. GALLANT FIELDS was urged along while off the pace, came under strong urging while off the rail on the turn, was driven five wide approaching the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while up for the show. AUGUST OSAGE chased the pace, had the right rein break near the half-mile pole, drifted in just after doing so, was well managed while three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, lugged in while the rider had little control in the stretch and weakened. MYSTICISM was away alertly, dueled on the outside, vied into the stretch and tired. HOT PURSUIT veered out at the start, was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, moved to six wide approaching the quarter-pole, continued under urging in upper stretch, faltered near the furlong marker and was eased then walked off.
