Footnotes

CORPORATE JUNGLE settled on the inside, moved closer on the far turn, waited for room coming to the five-sixteenths pole, squeezed through inside of SURPRISE STRIKE shortly thereafter, rallied along the rail, took the lead in upper stretch, had the rider lose his right rein outside the furlong marker, moved clear passing that marker, had the rider regain the rein outside the sixteenth-pole and maintained a safe advantage under steady urging. IMAGINING dropped to the inside early on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, came off the rail near the three-eighths pole, moved closer while under urging, swung five wide at the top of the stretch, gained ground while under a drive, drifted in under a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, was switched to a left-handed whip and finished with good energy to garner the place. SANTO GATO settled towards the front of the field, moved closer while two to three wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, lost touch with the winner entering the final furlong and weakened while just able to save the show. UNBRIDLED OCEAN was restless in the gate, lunged at the start, was reserved on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch, was forced in outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly to just miss the show. SIMBAMANGU settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn, came through inside the tiring pacesetter in the stretch and lacked the needed response. KANAGARO raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while two then three wide on the far turn, moved out a bit once straightened for the drive, held a good striking position in upper stretch, was carried in outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened. DREAM MAN went two to three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, came in and bothered CLEAR NOTE near the seven-sixteenths pole, was urged along on the far turn, drifted out under left hand urging approaching the furlong marker, drifted in under right hand urging near the sixteenth-pole and failed to menace in a green effort. ORDAINED showed good speed, set the clear pace on the inside, extended the advantage on the backstretch, came under urging on the far turn, was collared in upper stretch and gave way. SURPRISE STRIKE was taken in hand before the first turn, allowed ORDAINED to set the pace, followed that rival from second, closed the margin while urged along on the far turn but had nothing left for the drive. CLEAR NOTE lagged at the rear of the field, steadied when DREAM MAN came in near the seven-sixteenths pole and was no factor. (Rail at 18 Feet)
